Dear Friends,

It has been a year of celebrations. It is hard to believe that we started out **15 years ago** with a "Kids Club" that met on Thursdays. Most of the youth from our original group have grown and have children. Often they come back to see the photos of when they participated!

The House of Mercy has expanded from **one day of activities to 4 days of activities** including homework help, environmental, financial literacy, career education, art, music and many field trips. In June we held our 2nd **Video Camp with a Tolerance Theme**. 15 youth participated. Gary Horton, of UECDC led the discussion of racism and tolerance. HOM youth also participated in the 25th Anniversary **Walking in Black History. The public preview of the video will be announced soon ou our Facebook page.**

Thanks to the support of **so many volunteers** and donors we have expanded holiday support to include an Easter Egg Hunt, Thanksgiving Distribution, Christmas Store and Gift distribution to over 100 youth and families.

Our Community Garden has grown from 6 beds to over 27 raised beds with a chain link fence, storage shed, and composter. We have increased our yield 100 fold. Remaining Garden Gatherings are Aug 17th and a Harvest Celebration on Sept 5th at 6;00pm.

This summer House of Mercy Youth experienced a week at **Camp Notre Dame**, They look forward to it all year and come back singing. For some it is their first time away from home.

The House of Mercy has expanded its reach through the Eastside Grassroots Coalition. Over 80 community members have identified priorities, developed action steps, established boundaries and named our neighborhood We have held monthly meetings and received an Erie Community Foundation Grant. Meetings are the 2nd Thurs of each month at the JFK Center at 6:30pm. Join us!

During our summer activities, House of Mercy youth ate a healthy lunch, learned about different cultures through cooking and crafts and went on weekly field trips to Waldameer, Erie Zoo, Presque Isle and bowling. Those with the best attitude will celebrate at Splash Lagoon.




